



Copyright & Licensing

It is a legal requirement to comply with copyright law, and ensure you have the correct licence for performing musicals. The following guidelines explain the most common copyright and licensing questions. Further information can be found on the following website: www.copyrightandschools.org.

Classroom Use

You are free to use all our material in the classroom for teaching purposes. If you decide to stage this musical you will need a performing rights licence. This licence covers royalties due to composers and publishers of the work and protects you and your school from any possible contravention of these rights.

Performing a Small Spark Musical Production

The performance of a musical or nativity to an audience (other than pupils and staff) requires an Annual Performance Licence, even if it is a 'free' performance, wherever the performance takes place. Please note a Performing Rights Society (PRS) Licence does NOT cover musicals and nativities.

All our production packs include an annual performance licence which is valid for 12 months from the date of purchase. An Annual Performance Licence is title specific and includes permission for you to make an audio or video recording of your performance.

If you have previously purchased a production and your performance licence has now expired, you can purchase a new one online on the product page for your chosen musical.

File-sharing & Uploading

Downloading, copying, installing or sharing any material supplied by Small Spark Productions - including copying audio CDs, CD ROMs, MP3s, PDFs or any other digital files - are NOT permitted without obtaining a specific licence from Small Spark Productions. We will take immediate action should an incident of illegal file sharing be reported.
